



## DRILL PROGRAM COMMENCES AT SNAKE HILL PROSPECT

Northern Mining Limited is pleased to advise the commencement of a RAB drill program at the Snake Hill Prospect.

The drill program is planned to evaluate a portion of the broad 3 km long x 1.5 km wide surface gold geochemical anomaly identified by previous explorers and extended by Northern Mining (see ASX Release 21 November 2011).

Previous drilling within this broad anomaly identified a zone of +1 g/t mineralisation over a 500 metre strike length with reported intercepts of 2 metres grading 3.76 g/t Au from 44 metres, 2 metres grading 1.82 g/t Au from 38 metres and 2 metres grading 11.78 g/t Au from 129 metres.
